Volume 1, Part I, Section 2, Tender Data Sheet, ITT 24.1	Extension in the Tender Submission Date may be granted, as during the Christmas and year-end holidays Notary Public offices and relevant government departments remain closed, making timely completion and notarization of required documents difficult. It has also been indicated that, in order to submit a competitive and high-quality offer, both technically and financially, Tenderers are undertaking detailed site investigations and further design development to improve upon the conceptual design provided in the Tender Documents. Given the extent of these activities, Tender Submission Date may be extended for at least one month.	The Employer is of the view that a period of three (03) months has already been provided to the Tenderers for the preparation of their tenders, which is considered sufficient. Therefore, any further extension in tender submission date is regretted.

Volume 1, Part I, Section 4, Tender Forms Page 4-81 Form of Tender Security	Whether any changes or modifications in the prescribed forms of securities (including Bid Security, Advance Payment Guarantee, Performance Security, etc.) are acceptable, and whether bidders may submit these securities with amendments to the standard formats provided in the bidding documents.	The prescribed forms of securities provided in the Tender Documents shall be used. No material change, deviation, or conditionality in the content, wording, scope, or validity of the prescribed security formats shall be acceptable, and any submission containing such material alterations may render the Tender non-responsive. Any change / deviation in the submitted security will be determined by the Procurement Evaluation Committee during Tender evaluation stage, strictly in accordance with the Tender documents and applicable procurement rules.

Volume 2 Part II, Section 6, Employer's Requirements	As per the bidding requirements, the Tenderer is required to provide detailed information for six (06) new MTBMs. We respectfully submit that, at the bidding stage, it is not practically feasible to provide complete and finalized details of newly manufactured MTBMs. In this regard, we kindly seek clarification on whether it would be acceptable for the Tenderer to submit a formal declaration /undertaking confirming that, in the event of award of the Contract, the Tenderer shall procure,	Kindly refer to ITT 11.2 of the Tender Documents, submission of 'Manufacturer's Authorization for MTBM' issued by the OEM, in accordance with Page 4-97 is mandatory. Therefore, submission of a declaration or undertaking alone shall not be acceptable to meet the requirement. At the Tender stage, the Tenderer shall submit the minimum required technical details, specifications, and performance parameters for the proposed six (06) MTBMs, sufficient to demonstrate compliance with the Employer's Requirements / Tender

Volume 3, Part II, Section 6 Employer Requirements Dwg # LW-TD-411 to LW-TD-424	The detailed dimensions in the final disposal station layout drawings of the bidding drawings LW-TD-411~419 do not match those in LW-TD-421~424.	<p>It is clarified that the dimensions shown in drawings LW-TD-411~419 relate to the Schematic single line diagram of Pump house and inlet chamber cum Screening Chamber of the proposed Gulshan-e-Ravi Ultimate disposal station as per preliminary hydraulic design of consultant, whereas drawings LW-TD-421~424 indicates the foundation plan and Support of excavation (SOE) system i.e Bored piles for instant Construction activities.</p> <p>It is pertinent to mention that these drawings have been provided for reference purposes only. Being an EPC Contract, the Tenderer shall be responsible for carrying out the detailed design i.e. Hydraulic + Structure &amp; Foundation of the disposal stations, duly considering actual site conditions/ Geotechnical studies and fully complying with the requirements stipulated in the Employer's Requirements.</p>
5.	Volume 2 Part II, Section 6, Employer's Requirements	Is an OEM certificate on the company letterhead sufficient for the Micro TBM machines, or do we need to provide additional certificates?	The Tenderer is required to submit the Manufacturer's Authorization for the Micro TBM (MTBM) issued by the OEM, in accordance with Page 4-97 and ITT 11.2 of the Tender Documents. Furthermore, the OEM is required to comply with the specified parameters and submit the relevant certificates as stipulated under the MTBM OEM Criteria provided on Page 6-35 of the Employer's Requirements.
